We are living in a pivotal time, a time when women need to step fully into leadership roles without having to compromise and use so much masculine energy to 'get things done'. What would that look like, feel like, sound like? In our rapidly unfolding future, how can women fully embody the feminine aspect of themselves to create a balance with the strong masculine that they have had to inhabit and in many cases overplay?

Women are being called on to search deeply within themselves to find their unique power and authentic voice, knowing what we stand for and against and having the courage and skills to articulate this clearly, in order to become role models that will help build a sustainable future for our troubled planet.

During this 2.5 day experiential programme we will be living through the powerful myth of Demeter & Persephone. We will be exploring the Integration of the three archetypal stages and roles in a woman's life and work: Maiden, Mother, Wise Woman. We will investigate how we can move towards reunion and integration, both internally and externally, as we journey through these different stages.

This is a deeply personal journey that we invite women to travel on together in a contained, safe environment, in order to emerge as Persephone does in the story, regenerated, reborn and more fully herself.

Participants will work in a mixture of plenary, small groups and pairs, and will engage in reflection, experiential exercises, creative expression and rehearsals.

THEMES COVERED INCLUDE:

- Liberating ourselves and others in a culture of inequality and domination
- Appropriate emotion and effective action
- Reclaiming what's lost and relinquishing that which no longer serves

PARTICIPANTS WILL GAIN:

- A rejuvenated connection with yourself, other women, and nature
- Determination and confidence to own and stand more fully in your power
- New awareness, deep insight, and the sweetness of support to realise your dreams for your life and work as a woman
